

Context Information - Academy

Crookesbroom Primary Academy is a one form entry primary school with a 26 place morning only nursery. Currently, we have 236 pupils on roll. 40% of pupils are eligible for Pupil Premium and the academy has a deprivation indicator of 0.29. The school predominantly serves the community of Dunscroft, a small village in the east of Doncaster. At its most recent Ofsted inspection (January 2015), the academy was judged to be good with outstanding leadership and behaviour and safety.

Crookesbroom Primary Academy is a high performing school with a highly inclusive ethos. We believe that, through the pursuit of excellence, every child can achieve great things. Our curriculum is skills based and designed to promote learning which is active, engaging and child-led.
