What do we want our school to be like?

We want our school to be a friendly place where all children follow our school rules to keep everyone safe and happy.

How should we behave and why?

All children should behave in a way that allows all children to learn without any distractions. We should respect our teachers because they always try their best to help us learn. We should always make the right choice and do our very best learning all the time.

Golden rules we must follow

- Always be kind and thoughtful
- Always look after people and property
- Always do your very best
- Always listen carefully and follow instructions
- Always be responsible

Rewards for good behaviour

- Stickers / stamps
- Reward points to spend in our reward shop
- 100% attendance rewards
- Special class rewards
- Race to read reward prizes
- Gold head teacher stickers
- Weekly student of the week certificates

Our consequence behaviour chart

- If a child misbehaves, they are given a warning.
- If this continues, their name is recorded on C1.
- A tick will then be placed next to their name.
- If behaviour continues, they receive another tick and are removed for five minutes.
- If behaviour still doesn't improve, they go on a C4 and are removed from class for the rest of the lesson. Children then lose their next playtime.
- If their behaviour carries on, they then go on onto a C5 where you are removed from class for the whole morning / afternoon and miss your next playtime. Children will also then be banned from any clubs.
- In extreme cases, children will move on to a C6 where they are excluded from school for a set period of time.

Our promise

We will try our best to follow our school rules to ensure we are always safe, responsible and respectful.

When do we use our behaviour system?

Our behaviour system is used both inside and outside of the classroom, including at breaks and lunch times and when we are on out on school trips.
