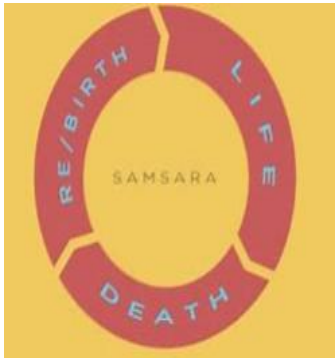
### Fascinating facts 1

At the end of time, God will raise everyone and judge them. Those who have their sins forgiven will go to heaven. Those who sin, will go to Hell.



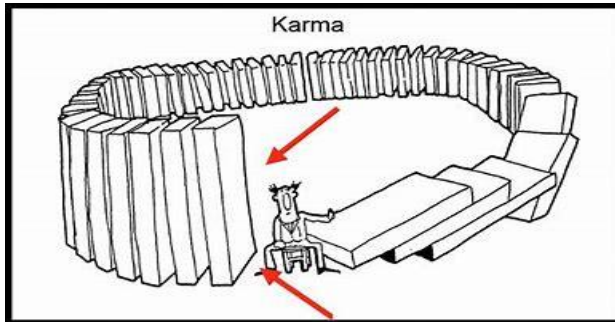
