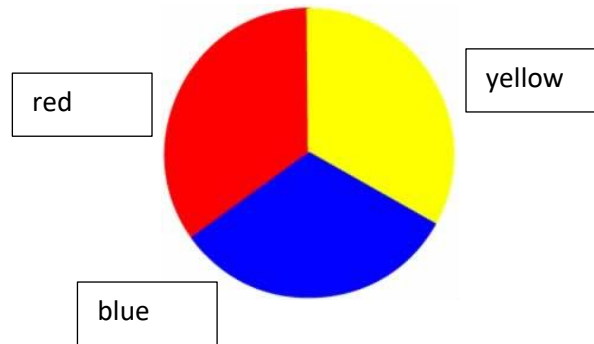
Can you remember some of the things you used in reception to make your own artwork?

Secondary colours are made by mixing two of the three primary colours together.

Key Vocabulary

Primary colours – A group of colours that make all other colours by mixing together.

Secondary colours – The colours made from mixing two primary colours together.

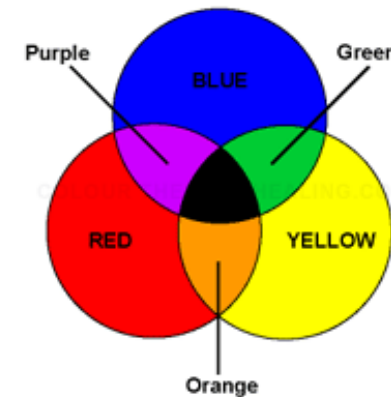
Media – Materials and tools used by an artist.

Realism – Art that represents real images of our everyday world.

Blue + yellow = green.

Yellow + red = orange.

Red + blue = purple.

Important Person

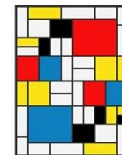


Piet Mondrain (1872-1944)

- He was a Dutch painter who worked mainly with primary colours.
- The majority of his artwork was abstract paintings, though he did create some realist art.
